Beginner

Level 4

- 1) Theme: An infraction, a robbery, and a funeral.
 - a) Look for responses to everyday police work situations.
 - b) Procedures and steps after the collection of information.
 - i) Citizen security
 - ii) Police structures: personal and institutional
 - iii) Routine questions to obtain information
 - iv) Transit signals and regulation
 - v) Regular and irregular verbs in the present
 - vi) Regular and irregular verbs in the future
 - vii) Phrases done in the imperfect: ("tenía, quería, había, era, estaba)

Intermediate

Level 1

- 1) Theme: The police officer's routine.
 - a) Tell about and describe the daily routine of a police officer.
 - i) Work hours
 - ii) Higher level orders (orders from the top)
 - iii) The commissioner
 - iv) Reflexive verbs and pronouns
 - v) Verbs of routine police work
 - vi) Review of verb tenses
- 2) Theme: Combating crime: Gangs and Drugs.
 - a) Giving orders in specific situations related to gangs and drugs.
 - i) Idiomatic expressions of the street (Latin America generally)
 - ii) Judicial vocabulary
 - iii) Imperative mode
 - iv) Verbs with direct and indirect objects

Level 2

- 1) Theme: Sharing experiences and police officers.
 - a) Describe events and stories from the past.
 - b) Talk about lived experiences in police work.
 - i) Work as a police officer: raids, patrols, seizure, kidnapping, detentions, arrests
 - ii) Imperfect tense
 - iii) Indefinite preterit in interaction with the imperfect
 - iv) Verbs with prepositions

Level 3

- 1) Theme: Who could the murderer be? Investigate!
 - a) Ponder the causes that bring an individual to commit murder.
 - i) Detective, clues, sketch, and profile of a murderer vocabulary
 - ii) Simple conditional
 - iii) Simple future

- 2) Theme: Why did he/she kill him? What motives did he/she have?
 - a) Inquire and discuss situations that imply probability, recommendations, choices, etc.
 - i) Weapons, equipment, supplies, infrastructure
 - ii) Some special verbs
 - iii) Direct and indirect objects
 - iv) Verbs in the present, past, and future

Level 4

- 1) Theme: What has happened during my experience as a police officer?
 - a) Describe things that have happened during your experience as a police officer.
 - i) Specific vocabulary of the police body
 - ii) Past participles
 - iii) Preterit perfect
- 2) Theme: The case report.
 - a) Describe the details of a criminal act in the past using police situations.
 - b) Analyze and explore different police situations.
 - i) General vocabulary and verbs related to police, weapons, public order, etc.
 - ii) Preterit pluperfect, indefinite, and imperfect
 - iii) Passive voice and "se" as passive

Advanced

Level 1

- 1) Theme: Serving society.
 - a) Describe the functions of your place of work.
 - b) Giving orders in different work situations.
 - i) Culture (urban order)
 - ii) Imperatives with direct and indirect objects and reflexives
 - iii) Reflexive pronouns and mandates
- 2) Theme: Fighting criminals.
 - a) Discuss the different forms of how to combat criminals in society.
 - i) Car theft, domestic violence, bank assaults, armed assaults, black market, etc.
 - ii) Review of all simple and compound tenses
 - iii) Prepositions
 - iv) Impersonal "se"

Level 2

- 1) Theme: Crime and punishment.
 - a) Discuss the most common crimes and punishments that exist in your country.
 - i) Types of crime (criminal and civil)
 - ii) Classification of crimes: against life, property, etc.
 - iii) Types of punishments: incarceration, deportation, torture, etc.
 - iv) Capital punishment, life imprisonment
 - v) Present subjunctive
- 2) Theme: Criminal psychology.
 - a) Analyze and discuss the reasons that an individual comes to develop sociopathic behavior.
 - i) Society and culture
 - ii) Mediums of communication
 - iii) Present subjunctive

Level 3

- 1) Theme: The history and origin of police forces in the world.
 - a) Explore and converse about the history and origin of police in the world.
 - i) Politics and economy
 - ii) Criminal law
 - iii) Levels of police (state, local, federal)
 - iv) Agencies of investigation and security
 - v) Imperfect subjunctive

- 2) Theme: The detective: the role of the woman in this field.
 - a) Talk and debate about the incorporation of females in policing.
 - i) Vocabulary
 - ii) Imperfect subjunctive
 - iii) Simple conditional clause
