

## Important Note:

The following schedule of visits, activities, and excursions is subject to change and substitution. In order for you to get the most out of the lectures and hands-on experience, you should be at least a **mid-intermediate** level Spanish speaker (approximately 4 semesters of Spanish in college, or 3 years of high school Spanish). If you are currently at a level below mid-beginner, you may still apply, but we strongly recommend that you also register for at least an additional 2 weeks of classes prior to the start of the SALUD program.

Of the 100 Spanish lessons, 60 will focus on Medical Spanish vocabulary and 40 will be General Spanish. There are three visits to hospitals/health centers in Navarra during class time. Specific times and dates may vary.

### **Six weeks or more in advance**

- \$100 registration fee due. Late registrants may apply, space permitting and will pay an additional \$35 late fee.

- Final payment is due. Payment received after the due date will be assessed a \$35 late fee.
