Program Purpose

This program is designed for non-native Spanish teachers who wish to expand upon and update their knowledge of second language methodologies and theories. Participants will be able to increase pedagogical expertise by discussing controversial grammatical topics, addressing how to integrate culture, history and politics into lessons, and reviewing other related issues that will enrich any classroom back home.

Program Highlights:

- **LECTURES & WORKSHOPS** – 30 hours each week of lectures and workshops in Spanish relating to Spanish culture, the educational system, methodology, curriculum, implementing tools in the classroom, homework, teaching materials, and more.
- **HOMESTAY** - lodging with a local Spanish family, includes a shared room, 2 meals daily, and laundry.
